She was appointed to Longwood University Board of Visitors in July 2011 by Governor Robert F. McDonnell and reappointed by Governor Terence R. McAuliffe. She served as rector of the board for two separate terms including the last two years of her service (2017-2019). She served as the Vice-Chairman of the Virginia Aviation Board to which she was appointed by Governor Mark R. Warner in July 2003 and reappointed by Governor Timothy M. Kaine in July 2007. She has also served on the boards of numerous non-profit organizations.

Marianne earned her Master of Public Administration degree with a specialization in public law from Bowling Green State University and is a graduate of Longwood University. She is a 1998 graduate of the Sorensen Institute for Political Leadership at the University of Virginia.
